

RANKING POINTS RE-CALIBRATION

In light of the major enhancements and changes to the Junior Sanctioned events, the following points are set out to explain the recalibration of the rankings.

- On September 1st, all ranking points will be re-calibrated using the current U19s values, including all historical results.

Note: We no longer have a regional points level, points from these tournaments in 2016 won't count in the new system, as previously communicated.

- A player's best seven results from the previous 12-months are used to calculate their ranking (best six for U19).
- When aging up, players take up their best four results at 50%. These will be replaced as they play more tournaments. Players can only use two results from the lower group (at 50%) assuming they are then in their best seven (or six)
- Player can also use two results from the age group above, also assuming they are then in their best seven (or six).
- A player can appear in more than one age group ranking but they must play in one event in a particular age group before they are eligible to appear.
- Before a player moves up to the next age group, he/she may play tournaments in the higher age group. Those points will count towards their higher age group ranking (keeping in mind all the points will be at the same flat rate).
