

Participation programme grant guidance

England Squash affiliated clubs can now apply for a £250 grant to kick-start either a Squash 101 or Squash Girl Can participation programme.

This funding is intended to support affiliated clubs to implement participation programmes which offer an alternative opportunity to engage beginners or those who play less frequently.

Clubs can use the funding to:

- pay for coaches to deliver sessions
- train Squash 101 leaders to deliver sessions
- pay for venue hire
- marketing and promotion
- equipment.

Eligibility

To be eligible, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- be an England Squash affiliated club
- be able to begin the programme at the club by February 2019
- commit to recording the participants on the England Squash app.

We will prioritise applications that:

- show how the funding will be used, detailing what the programme will look like at the club and how the money will be spent
- demonstrate the need for the participation programme at their club / venue and the impact Squash 101 or Squash Girls Can will have on the club
- demonstrate how the programme will become sustainable at their club / venue
- demonstrate how their club plans to attract participants to the programmes, recognising that the programmes are designed to engage new players.
