



## The British Open Championship Men Roll of Honour

Charles Read (Eng) beat Oke Johnson (Eng) in 1920 to win the inaugural Professional Championship and repeated the win in the second event in 1928.

The Amateur Championship was also held prior to 1930 from the inaugural event in 1922.

The British Open Championship was instituted in 1930, with Charles Read (Eng) designated champion.

The Open Championship was played on a challenge system until 1947.
