



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS

As a parent or carer of a child or young person taking part in an activity at our club, we'd like you to:

- Take time to talk to your child about their involvement in squash and what they want to achieve - remember it is their game
- Listen to your child if they say they don't want to do something and gently ask them why - something might be wrong
- Be respectful of everyone participating (coaches, staff, volunteers, officials, young people, parents and other teams and staff)
- Behave positively and encourage your child and their peers
- Never shout or criticise if your child makes a mistake
- Let your child know you are proud of them
- Respect and accept official's judgements and do not enter the 'field of play'
- **Show support and empathy towards Junior Referees who are doing their best to manage a very complicated game - remember they are children just trying to do their best so if a mistake is made, be kind and patient**
- Talk to us if you have any concerns about any part of your child's involvement, we'd love to hear from you
- Talk to your child about embracing sportsmanship
- Encourage your child to play by the rules
- Ensure your child understands the Code of Conduct
