Parking

There is no parking on site at this venue. Parking is only available on the neighbouring streets and carparks. **There is no free on street parking on Friday and Saturday before 6.30pm.** Fees are payable. (max 3 hours in the same location). You will be required to move your vehicle to a new location within 3 hours. On-street parking is free on Sundays. It is recommended to use public transport where possible. Alternatively parking at the O2 centre on [Finchley road](#) is available but at a cost of £25 for 6-7 hours (or £35 for 7-10 hours).

Café/Catering

The club has a full food and bar service which will be open from 8.30am and until 9pm.

Tournament Desk

Tim Vail (07939 005959) is the lead contact for Cumberland and the tournament desk will be located upstairs by court 3.

No Dogs are permitted on site at any time.

Changing Facilities and Bag

The club has limited changing room facilities and are relatively small. Cumberland will be adopting the England Squash Safeguarding policy for the entirety of the event. Where possible, adults should accompany children into the changing areas.

Bags should be stored by court 3. The saunas are out of bounds and should not be used by any of the participants.

Gym

This is for the use of the members only and should not be used by any tournament participants.

No smoking within the grounds of the club.

Drinking Water

The club has a no plastic policy and does not supply cups for the fountains. You will be responsible for using your own water bottle.

First Aid

First aid kits are located at the bar and the tournament desk. All staff and tournament desk staff are first aid trained.

Physio

Adam Boucher was a professional tennis player and trained in osteopathy with a strong emphasis in sport related injuries. He will be at the Cumberland on Friday and Saturday from 12pm – 6pm outside of court 3. He will be available for treatment, questions etc. This service is free to players so please make use of him in the allocated time.

Parking

Anti-Doping

By entering this event, you agree to abide by the rules and regulations governing the championships and declare that you are aware of the Anti-Doping regulations and procedures as set out in Section E and Appendix G of the WSF World Championship Regulations. You accept that you may be tested under these regulations at any stage of the championships and will be subject to the penalties set out in the World Championship Regulations if the test(s) prove positive. This declaration covers participation throughout all stages of the event, including plate rounds.

Clothing

Players must wear clothing suitable for squash. If the Referee determines there's a conflict in shirt colour, the lower ranked player must change their shirt. On the all-glass court, there must be a clear difference in shirt colour.

Player Withdrawal

A player may withdraw without penalty before 12:00pm on the Monday prior to the start of the tournament. Any withdrawal after this deadline and before the start of a player's first match is considered a late withdrawal. Withdrawal after the start of the tournament must be notified to the Event Director as soon as possible by email with a valid reason. The reason for withdrawal should then be confirmed within 7 days. In the event of illness or injury, written confirmation should be accompanied by a letter of explanation from a parent or coach and a medical certificate.

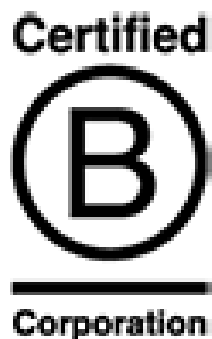

Qualified England Squash Referees and Marking of Matches

England Squash are providing referees for matches throughout the event. For matches that do not have an England Squash referee allocated, both players of the previous match must referee the next match on court. This is a mandatory requirement for playing in the event. Please discuss any refereeing concerns with the tournament desk.



Tournament Ball

Dunlop is England Squash's official ball and clothing partner and provide the balls for the event. The Dunlop Pro (double yellow spot) will be used for all events at the tournament, other than the mixed under 9 (MU9) category which will use the Dunlop Competition (single yellow spot) ball.

Registration and Tournament Desks

All players must sign in at the venue's tournament desk at least 30 minutes before their first match. We cannot accept parents or guardians signing in on a player's behalf. Players will receive their event t-shirt during registration.

Please direct all enquiries to the staff on the tournament desks. They are there to help and ensure the event runs smoothly for all involved.
