

World Squash Day club grant guidance

This funding is for affiliated clubs to deliver a female focused event for International Women's Day.

Clubs can use the funding to on anything to support the event including, but not limited to:

- Paying for coaches to deliver sessions.
- Training Squash 101 leaders to deliver sessions.
- Pay for venue hire.
- Marketing and promotion.
- Paid for social media marketing.
- Equipment.

About the grant

- The grant is available to England Squash affiliated clubs only.
- The event must be delivered by an appropriately qualified coach or Squash 101 leader.
- The coach delivering the event must be an England Squash Coaches Club member.
- The event must take place between 1st and 8th March 2020.
- There is a limited number of grants available so make your application as compelling as possible (we expect to receive a high volume).
- The deadline for applications on 17th January 2020 at 12:00.
- Successful applicants will be notified by 20th January 2020.
- Clubs must record at least 10 female participants to receive the grant.
- The grant will be paid once the event has taken place and 10 new female players have been recorded via the England Squash app 'Squash Girls Can' session type.

Eligibility

To be eligible, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be an England Squash affiliated club.
- The event must be delivered by an appropriately qualified coach who is an England Squash Coaches Club member, or a Squash 101 Leader.
- Commit to recording the participants on the England Squash app.
- Record a minimum of 10 new female players to receive the grant.
