We're recruiting for a short-term project-based role to provide support to clubs and county associations during the Return to Play.

c.6-8 days a month until September 2021 (with the possibility of a further extension).

Having gleaned insight into the attitudes and barriers amongst players around returning to court, England Squash is producing a range of support and guidance for clubs and county associations to drive participation and a re-engagement of players.

We are looking for someone with excellent communication skills who can connect effectively with county associations and squash clubs, bringing the community together after one of the toughest years in the sport's history.

You will:

- Drive awareness of the Bounce Back support and campaign amongst clubs and county associations
- Engage with clubs on return to play initiatives and campaigns
- Support county associations in sharing information to clubs on return to play plans
- Support the delivery of Return to Play webinars for county associations and clubs
- Be the main point of contact for and maintain relationships with county associations
- Coordinate content for Club Connect and produce monthly county updates
- Support the creation of new content, such as 'how to' guides and case studies
- Gather and share feedback from clubs and county associations
- Provide support for other England Squash participation programmes and campaigns such as World Squash Day and Squash Girls Can Coach
