Road to Selection is an objective, points-based selection system allowing players, parents and coaches to track progress towards England selection throughout the season.

A player must be an active member of the squad programme and Road to Selection to be considered for representation.

Results achieved in events not included in Road to Selection or results from a different age group will not be considered. We wish to encourage players to seek competition amongst peers in their own age group.

*Selection occurs approximately six weeks prior to the event to allow for completion of the selection process and (any) subsequent appeals to be considered/resolved. Flexibility might be required to accommodate ESF/WSF tournament entry deadlines.

Junior Selection Events 2023-2024



Points will be awarded depending on a players finishing position in selection events as outlined below. The divisor will be the best 4 results from 7 selection events for U13 and U15s, 3 from 6 for U17s, 3 from 5 for U19 Europeans and 3 from 6 for World Junior Championships.



A Road to Selection standings table will be published following each selection event. This will include the top eight players in each age group. Players aging out will be removed from the next release of the standings.
