Key priorities

- Support local venues to organise Squash 101 and /or Squash Girls Can session(s).
- Deliver Squash 101 / Squash Girls Can sessions.
- Identify opportunities to train volunteers, coaches and leisure facility staff as Squash 101 leaders.
- Ensure those who deliver programmes use the England Squash app for monitoring.
- Be an advocate of the participation programmes.
- Support local activity during campaigns such as World Squash Day and Women's Squash Week.

What we're looking for

For this role you will be a Squash 101 leader or squash coach who:

- Is passionate about leading sessions aimed at new adult (16+) players.
- Has existing local connections within squash and is able to build relationships with organisations and individuals.
- Is committed to growing squash participation locally.
- Has success in engaging and motivating new adult (16+) players.
- Has excellent communication and organisational skills.
- Is enthusiastic and proactive and able to motivate others.

Support for the Squash 101 Champion

- Induction / Orientation Day attendance at the orientation day is mandatory and will give you the chance to meet with other champions, and find out more about the role and support available.
- Squash 101 Champion kit.
- England Squash will provide all the materials needed to deliver the programmes as well as regular contact with England Squash staff.
- Opportunity to apply for funding for innovative projects and activities linked to the role.
- Mentoring and support. You'll be part of a community of Squash 101 Champions where you can share ideas, ask questions and learn from others.
- We will inform you about opportunities for CPD whether that's in coaching, refereeing, becoming a tutor or other opportunities.
