Role description

Squash Girls Can coach is a 12 month mentoring initiative for those who want to become a coach or progress from a level 1 coach to level 2. Whether you'd like to spend an hour a week running a session at your local venue to inspire new players, or you're considering embarking on career in coaching our team of Squash Girls Can coach mentors will help you build your coaching experience. Squash Girls Can coach candidates will;

- Attend a level 1 coaching course between January 2020 and March 2020 with their allocated mentor (unless already level 1 qualified).
- Attend a minimum 5 face to face mentoring and workshops throughout the 12 months.
- Receive regular support from you mentor and the network of coaches on the programme.

Costs

Successful candidates must pay for 50% of their coaching course prior to attending.

Level 1 = £92.50

Level 2 = £135

Upon successful completion of all the programme requirements that cost will be reimbursed.

Timescales

23rd September 2019 – applications open

22nd November 2019 - closing date for applications

January 2020 – March 2020 mentoring programme begins with candidates attending either a level 1 coaching course with their allocated mentor.

What we're looking for?

We're looking for candidates who;

- can commit to the 12 month initiative
- have the support of a club or venue from where they will undertake coaching
- will deliver at least 12 coaching sessions (group sessions for a level 1 coach, group and/or individual for level 2)
- are committed to developing their coaching skills and confidence
- are able to attend a minimum of 6 workshops organised by their mentor
- are passionate and enthusiastic about engaging more squash players at all levels
- will be a positive role model.
