



Tournament Organisers Information

Junior Sanctioned Silver competitions are 3-day competitions which attract higher ranked English players. Players can expect to play up to 4 or 5 games across the competition depending on draw sizes.

England Squash Sanctioned Event Requirements

1. Venue Requirements

- a. Venues must hold a valid England Squash Affiliation at the time of the event.
- b. A registered Safeguarding/Welfare Lead must be in place, with a valid safeguarding qualification and DBS registered with England Squash.
- c. A qualified first aider must be present for the entire competition.

2. Tournament Organiser Requirements

- a. Must have a valid England Squash membership, DBS check, safeguarding qualification, and Tournament Organiser qualification registered with England Squash.
- b. Must be appointed as the main contact for all disputes regarding entries, scheduling, and refereeing.
- c. Responsible for ensuring a safeguarding lead is available for the full duration of the competition.

3. Competition Management

- a. England Squash will organise seedings, draws and assist with scheduling.
- b. Final finishing positions must be submitted into Sport Manager, followed by a claims form for payment of entry fees (minus the levy)

Entry information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On-line entry through Sport Manager • England Squash members • Entry fee: £40 • Closing date: 3 weeks pre-competition • Acceptances will be based on the England Squash Rankings at the time of the closing date. • International players must be ranked within the top 10 of their age category in their respective country. International players will not get an automatic entry into the draw- this will be decided by the seeding panel. • Double Dot balls to be used for all age groups except U9's which use single dot balls.
Formats	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Best of 3 games • Draw Sizes and formats will depend on entry numbers and number of courts available. • If a category has less than 16 players entered, alternative draw formats may be used i.e. round robin • All matches must be able to be completed over only 2 days. I.e. No matches should take place on a Friday. • Where there is a full draw players entered into an event and the event is oversubscribed, players will be placed onto the waitlist.
Timings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Players are recommended to have a minimum 2 hours, U13s, U15s, U17 and U19s between scheduled match start times. U9s and U11s are recommended to have a minimum of 1 hour between scheduled match start times. • When scheduling events use the following match timings: U9 & U11 - 15 minutes U13, U15, U17 & U19 - 20 minutes
International Players	<p>International players will not get an automatic entry. Players will only be entered if they are seeded in the top 32 of all entrants.</p>

Gold	£18.50 per player

Tournament Software

1. All competitions sanctioned by England Squash for the 2025-26 season will be run using Sport Manager as the tournament software. This is mandatory for all sanctioned competitions. Training and support will be provided by England Squash.
2. All competition organisers must submit their competition final finishing positions into Sport Manager within 48 hours of their tournament finishing.
