## World Squash Day club grant guidance

This funding is intended to help World Squash Day delivery partners offer an activity for newer players to join after World Squash Day. Clubs can apply for a £250 participation grant to deliver Squash 101 or Squash Girls Can.

Clubs can use the funding to:

- Pay for coaches to deliver sessions.
- Train Squash 101 leaders to deliver sessions.
- Pay for venue hire.
- Marketing and promotion.
- Equipment.

## About the grant

- The grant is available to England Squash affiliated clubs only and World Squash Day delivery partners only.
- The grant is available for the delivery of a Squash 101 programme, or a Squash Girls Can programme. These participation programmes must be aimed at those over the age of 16.
- The participation programmes must be delivered on an ongoing basis, either weekly, fortnightly or monthly.
- The programmes must start between 14<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> October 2019
- Too be successful clubs must have recorded a minimum of 20 people at their World Squash Day activities on the England Squash app by 12<sup>th</sup> October 2019.
- There is a limited number of grants available so make your application as compelling as possible (we expect to receive a high volume).
- An initial payment of £150 will be made from Monday 14<sup>th</sup> October on the condition that you have added your World Squash Day players to the England Squash app.
- The remaining £100 will paid once new 20 unique participants have been recorded at the sessions on the <u>England Squash app</u> ( this must be before 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020).

## Eligibility

To be eligible, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be an England Squash affiliated club and registered as a World Squash Day delivery partner.
- Have added a minimum of 20 adult players at your World Squash Day events (by 12<sup>th</sup> October).
- Be able to begin the programme at the club between 14<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> October following on from your World Squash Day activities.
- Commit to recording the participants on the England Squash app.
